

Membership Secretary Report

Annual membership fees, set at £10 since our inception in 2013, remain a source of income for the company.

Being able to demonstrate the size of our membership is also important in defining the extent of liability for our personal accident insurers. This is why it is essential that cast members pay their membership fee as soon as they are accepted onto a production.

Currently (at end June 2023), there are 39 paid up members and this number has remained roughly static during the reporting year.

In addition to our paid members we have a mailing list of contacts who receive updates about our activities generally. Currently the size of this list is 895.

This demonstrates that our audience reach is much larger than the number of persons who decide to financially support us and to become involved in our productions. This situation is common among community groups particular those based in areas such as London with constantly changing populations.

There are no plans to increase the membership fee though I note that had it increased in line with inflation since we launched 10 years ago its value would now be: £14:60. (Source: Office of National Statistics CPI inflation).
