As promised, here are the details of my production of Chekhov's final masterpiece *The Cherry Orchard*. The show will be staged from 15th July to 2nd August at the Jack Studio Theatre in South London. Produced by my company DogOrange, who this year became Associate Company at the Jack Studio. This will be our 8th production and the first time we have returned to the genius of Chekhov since our Stage Award nominated, Time Out Critic's Choice production of *Ward No. 6*. It's a new adaptation by Writer's Guild award winning playwright Brendan Murray and features original music composed by Maria Haik Escudero. It features 15 actors, all of whom do some truly magical choral singing throughout the show plus 8 of them play instruments right there on stage in front of your lovely eyes, bringing Chekhov's musical references to life.
