STC plan to perform the 'play for voices' (think radio play) <u>Sunday Morning</u> at the Centre of the World by Louis de Bernières for the Streatham Festival in October.



Performances: Thursday 17th & Friday 18th October at 7.30pm & Saturday 19th October at 2.30pm. Venue: The Chapel at the British Home, Crown Lane, SW16 3JB.

Written partly in homage to Dylan Thomas's *Under Milk Wood*, this play is a tragi-comic account of a few hours in the lives of some of Louis de Bernières' neighbours when he lived in Earlsfield during the 1980s writing Captain Corelli's Mandolin.
