Join us to listen, act out the pieces, give feedback and suggest staging.

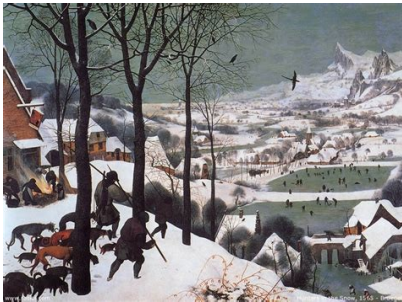
If you are an actor, director, stage manager or audience member we need you to come along and perform, listen, and give constructive feedback to our playwrights.
