Submissions (10 minutes maximum run-time; no extracts from longer works) should be sent to info@streathamtheatre.org.uk titled "Streatham Shorts" to arrive no later than **Wednesday 27th August**.

This is a great way to expose your writing to the scrutiny of an audience and measure their response!

To make our lives easier, please include on the document: your name and contact details, the title of the play and the list of characters.

Selected writers will be notified by **September 2nd** and should be available on the night of the [workshop](#) 9th September to introduce their piece in person.

Please note: entries may also be subsequently performed by STC actors, for example at our Christmas "Streatham's Got Talent" event.
