Polonius	Claudius's chief counsellor, father to Ophelia and Laertes
Laertes	Polonius's son, recently returned to Elsinore from Paris
Ophelia	Daughter of Polonius and sister of Laertes. In love with Hamlet
Horatio	Hamlet's best friend from childhood
