His most famous book is The Devil Rides Out, published in 1934 shortly after Streatham Hill Theatre opened. It is rumoured that the theatre was built over a very auspicious site for devil worship, and that there have been some very spooky goings on there. This behind the scenes tour hopes to spread some light into the darkness...or maybe the other way round!?
